## **GRADING POLICY**

Grading policy has two parts: grading of pre-exam and exam activities. For all activities, students will reach a certain number of points.

## FINAL EXAM has a practical and written part.

**Practical exam:** During the practical exam, there will be 26 structures marked on specimens. Student must recognize and correctly write the name of at least 14 structures to pass. **Grading of the practical exam:**

Once a student passes the practical exam, it is valid for **that and the next exam period** (e.g., if you pass practical exam in June and fail the written exam, in the next exam period in July, you don't have to retake the practical exam. However, if you fail the written exam in July, you must retake the practical exam during the first term of the September exam period).

**Written exam:** The written exam has 74 questions in MCQ form or short answer form. **Grading of the written exam:**
